On August 18, 2010 Flatbush based emcee Tah Phrum Duh Bush releases his uncommon, self-exploratory voyage of a project: "Luminous Dark Alleys: The Insomniac Works". After a long battle with insomnia complicated by countless mishaps and personal trials, Tah has conjured up a collection of musical, visual, and literary works that will rattle the anticipations of the most originality-starved enthusiast. Projects like this, from an independent artist, are beyond rare... they are non-existent.

The full length LP is an album worthy of praise from Hip Hop aficionados who are die-hard fans of lyricism with intricate flows and heavy content to match. Tah's tour de force commands the listener's attention and garners both empathy for the man himself and an appreciation for Tah's solid and very authentic flow. This project is indicative of an *adult* who has been dragged through the ringer of sleeplessness and has seasoned his lyrical chops before he put them onto the grill for final preparation before consumption.

The literary work is a full-length book. It is a ride through a vast and vivid mindscape of self-discovery and blatant, vulnerable honesty. The sleepless now have something they can point to and say, "I know exactly where he is coming from". Those who do sleep will never view sleep the same way.

The visual work is a combination of embedded line drawings by Tah himself that began as sketches during the birthing of the book along with additional line drawings by renowned visual artist, Art Battles "Femme Fatale" champion Demostina. The cover art is derived from two paintings by Demostina that were inspired by the project.

Tah is a New York City based Emcee, DJ, Writer, and Emergency R.N. who immerses himself in the urban arts and indulges in world perspectives. Tah is one of the original co-founders of Urban Art Beat His two albums *The Untitled EP* and *Sunshine or Pure Shade* have earned countless praises from an international audience. In his music and writing, Tah utilizes dark comedy to explore fresh ways of expressing the dichotomies of life, often delving into the mysteries of the human thought process.
