

Facts about Tah Phrum Duh Bush

- Tah was born at some point in time
- Tah had his first experience with Hip Hop when he watched the school bully lose an emcee battle on the basketball court and remain undaunted by the jeers and insults.
- 1990 Tah, DJ Dom-Nice, Man-Duro and Sir Price form the group RAS Productions that later becomes the underground crew “Absolute Value”. Absolute Value records it’s first song “My Profession” which is Tah’s first time in a real “studio”
- 1990 Tah works part time jobs and packs bags at a supermarket until he earn enough to buy two turntables and a mixer
- 1991 Absolute Value does a string of shows with DJ Red Alert and Tracy Morgan
- 1991 Absolute Value performs with Black Moon and the Bush Babies
- 1991 Tah buys his first Sampler an Akai S900 and his first Drum Machine, the Yamaha RY-30
- 1993 Absolute Value breaks up.
- 1999 Tah Wins 5th Place in the John Lennon Song Writing Contest for the song “Up In It Raw”
- 1999-2001Tah creates, edits, publishes and distributed the underground cult publication “Ghetto Barbershop Monthly” that inspired publications such as “The Connex List” and “Rusty Jabs”
- 2000 Tah takes second place to Tone Deff in the Hookt.com Cyber Challenge Emcee Battle Semi-Finals.
- Released his first single “Middle Finga / Blown Owt” 2001 on 12” Vinyl and CD
- Tah flies to San Francisco for the Mic Checks 2001 emcee battle and comes in a miserable 10th place. Meets and befriends Bay Area battle legend Orukusaki.
- 2002 Tah does a theater stint with Mwalim at the Harlem Theater Company for a production called “OM!”
- Released “The Untitled EP” in 2003
- 2004 Tah is invited to and attends his first “Music Strategies” with the legendary Tim Sweeney
- 2005-2006 Tah collaborates with Conscious and Sinton to bring “Relax Star Vibe School” to M-Bar in NYC. It was a weekly chill event with open turntables and sporadic open mic segments. Relax Star Vibe School featured the City’s very first J Dilla tribute party that was featured on OKPlayer.com
- 2005 One night, after dropping a drunk friend home after Relax Star Vibe School Tah, couldn’t find an open restroom so he stops to urinate and is arrested. Tah spent the night in jail for “public exposure of a person”... Now that’s GANGSTA
- Released the debut full length LP “Sunshine Or Pure Shade” in 2005
- Tah starts his legendary shameless self-promotion campaign with enormous protest styled signs.
- 2006 Tah goes on the Hip Hop Palooza Tour with Brother M.A.N.I.A.C., Jimmy Black, KLM, D&D Productions, KLM and Michael J and Princess Of Controversy
- Tah is Awarded a plaque for being “Most Shameless Self Promotion Emcee” at the Freestyle Mondays Anniversary Celebration

- Co-founded Urban Art Beat a Hip Hop program for underprivileged youth in South Bronx, NY in 2006 <http://UrbanArtbeat.org>
- 2006 Tah battles female emcee Likwuid in the Jumpoff.com freestyle street battles at Ground Zero NYC and is catapulted into the land of “bad publicity”. After a backfired attempt to nullify Likwuid’s “small genitalia” and “gay” punch lines leads to a battle loss, Tah gains an abundance of new gay fans! It is even rumored that this not so classic “Freestyle Fail” inspired an episode of Family Guy. Even when Tah loses he wins. Tah and Likwuid remain good friends to this day.
- Tah is not gay. (Sorry Fellas) (Holla Ladies)
- 2007 Tah Wins the Off the Head Gameshow Battle @ Sin Sin NYC for the first time.
- Spring 2007 Tah Releases the “Flatbush Remixes”
- Tah tours the West Coast with Propaganda Anonymous and Loki Da Trixta for the “Aluminum is the New Gold Tour”
- 2007 Sunshine Or Pure Shade goes “Aluminum” and Tah Celebrates with a concert featuring Homeboy Sandman, Rugged N Raw and Webbfied.
- Created and implemented a Hip Hop based self discovery project at Pathways Home for Youth Bronx, NY in 2007
- May 2007 Tah Performs in Central Park for Earth Day in front of 7000 people
- 2007 Tah Wins The Upper States Independent Music Award for “Favorite Male” in the Hip Hop Category.
- February 2008 Tah Wins the Off the Head Game Show Battle at Sin Sin NYC taking down renowned battle champ Chaz Kangas in the last round
- 2008 Tah Phrum Duh Bush and Super King Armor set off the innovative monthly freestyle competition “A to Z eMcee” at Vox Pop in Brooklyn, NY.
- Traveled to Czech Republic in 2008 for the release of Jaro Cossiga’s Hop ‘n Nob an international compilation of Hip Hop music by Jaro Cossiga that was recorded at Tah’s studio in Brooklyn, NY
- 2008 Appeared on Czech national TV for the first televised performance of Semi-Reserved Closet Maniac.
- 2009 Opened for the Czech Republic National Slam Poetry Finals and DJ’d the after party.
- Conceptualized, created the curriculum for and is preparing to tour with the seminar “Networking for Non-Knowing How to Network Networkers”
- May – August 2009 Tah Creates and implements “The TahVinci Code” a treasure hunt for his fans where money and items were placed around NYC and clues were given via facebook, twitter and email. There was also an online version that fans played worldwide.
- August 27th 2009 Tah’s home catches fire and burns him out of a place to live and his recording studio.
- September 2009. The people on the underground scene nationwide rally together to hold 2 benefits for Tah.
- July 2010 Tah and Coole High perform at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas and then tour LOA and San Francisco Bay Area

- Released the single “Semi-Reserved Closet Maniac” and the Book/CD “Luminous Dark Alleys: The Insomniac Works” August 2010
- Tah along with Coole High and Gustav Gauntlet put on the groundbreaking “Future Insomniac” concert. This theatrical concert will ring about in infamy as Tah, Coole and Gus put on a show that will forever change how Hip Hop concerts are done!
- Tah’s favorite food is Sushi
- Tah is currently the main Master of Ceremonies for Baby Loves Disco
